

## Workplace Bathrooms Guide

- ♣ Maintain bathrooms and showers and any associated amenities in a clean and sanitary condition.
- ♣ The frequency of cleaning and disinfection will vary depending on usage.
- ♣ Use a “wipe-twice” method to clean and disinfect high-touch shower surfaces such as faucets, door handles, soap and towel bars. Wipe these kinds of surfaces with a cleaning agent to clean off soil and wipe again with a disinfectant.
- ♣ Consider physical distancing of users in order to prevent the spread of COVID-19. Distancing can be facilitated by the use of partitioned stalls, decommissioning toilets or urinals that are less than 2 meters apart or staggering entry into locker rooms
- ♣ Post signage in bathrooms and shower areas, that informs users of how to mitigate risks of COVID-19 transmission (E.g., hand hygiene, respiratory etiquette).
- ♣ Where necessary, maintain an adequate supply of soap, paper towel, toilet paper, hand sanitizer and other supplies.
